



ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

California Aeronautical University selects candidates for admission based on a holistic review process, which includes considering the candidate's ability to meet admissions requirements, personal character traits, and commitment to excel in the aviation industry. All candidates will be interviewed and must be recommended for acceptance.

GENERAL MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- At least 17 years old
- High school diploma (or equivalent)
- Pass entrance assessment (or have qualifying SAT scores)

FLIGHT PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Profile assessment
- Drug screen
- Medical clearance from FAA examiner
 - Class 2 (mandatory)
 - Class 1 (recommended)
- TSA documentation
 - U.S. CITIZENS:
 - Valid, unexpired U.S. passport AND
 - Copy of birth certificate OR U.S. naturalization certificate OR Certification of birth abroad OR Certificate of U.S. citizenship
 - NON-U.S. CITIZENS:
 - TSA approval through AFSP

GRADUATE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Two letters of reference
- Admissions essay
- Bachelor's degree in a related field from an accredited institution
