

COVID-19 Suspension of Flight Training Center Operations

Ventura County (KOXR) and San Diego County (KMYF) Flight Training Center Information:

The University wants to confirm for all students receiving their flight lab course training that all activities have been suspended until further notices driven by COVID-19. With the Governors Order recently issued to "stay at home" and in interest of the health and safety of all of our students and employees, the university wanted to provide this clear guidance regarding our decision to temporarily suspend operations. Following the lifting of government orders or with new information otherwise developing regarding COVID-19, we anticipate to resume to new normal operations as appropriate and will communicate as such when we are able.

All other non-flight lab courses that are currently being delivered using online distance education resources will continue as scheduled. In an effort to ensure everyone's success using distance education resources please reach out sooner than later with any questions or difficulties by contacting your instructor or the student success team. Contact information should be available online to reach out to technical support or otherwise directly or call the campus to speak to someone in the education department.
