Dear CAU Students,

The U.S. Department of Education (DOE) made available an additional \$21.2 billion to higher education institutions to ensure learning continues for students during the COVID-19 pandemic under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) as Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II). Additional information about these funds is located here: CRRSAA: Higher Education Emergency

California Aeronautical University (CAU) has signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used or will use the applicable amount of funds designed under the CRRSAA (a) (4) program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

In making such financial aid grants to students, CAU has prioritized grants to students with exceptional need, such as students who receive Pell Grants. However, students do not need to be Pell eligible to receive a HEERF II Grant. Students who are not eligible for a Pell Grant may apply for a HEERF II Grant by completing a Request for HEERF II Grant form. In addition to completing the form explaining their exceptional need (such as loss of job for themselves, spouse, or a family member, illness, etc.), students must submit a copy of their documentation to support their exceptional need. The Request for HEERF II Grant form and supporting documentation may be submitted to CAU's Office of Financial Services electronically or in person.

The grants distributed to students were disbursed to students either directly to themselves in a form of a check or, if authorized by the student, posted to their student account to be used for tuition, flight fees, technology fee, and/or on-campus housing.

Therefore, as of June 30, 2021, CAU has distributed most of the funds allocated from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students to 142 currently eligible students totaling \$170,400.
