Dear CAU Students,

The U.S. Department of Education (DOE) made available an additional \$39.6 billion in support to institutions of higher education to serve students and ensure learning continues during the COVID 19 pandemic under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) by the American Rescue Plan (ARP). ARP funds are in addition to funds authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) and the Coronavirus Aid, Recovery, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. Additional information about these funds is located here: ARP: American Rescue Plan (HEERF III).

In September 2021, California Aeronautical University (CAU) signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution will use the applicable amount of funds designed under the American Rescue Plan (HEERF III) program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

As of September 30, 2021, CAU was in the process of determining eligibility of HEERF III grants to students. Information on how to apply for a HEERF III grant will be available to CAU students as soon as possible but no later than October 29, 2021.
