ARRIVAL AT CAU

Coordinating the arrival of students can be challenging, but we have a successful plan in place for Move-In Day!

Move-In Day Itinerary

10:00 – 16:00 Move in to assigned room and get settled

17:00 – 18:00 Dinner at Skyway Café

18:00 – 19:30 Tour of campus and Orientation (meet at Skyway Café)

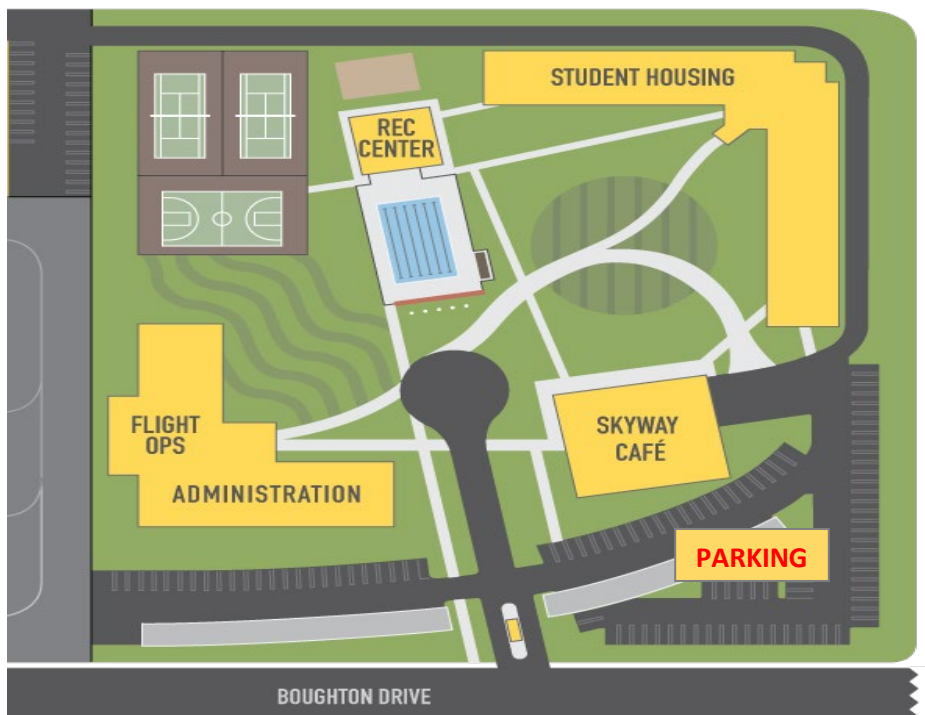
If flying into the Bakersfield Airport on move-in day, a CAU representative will be located in the baggage claim area of the terminal to pick you up and transport you to the campus.

If driving to CAU on move-in day, we ask that you park in the lot located to the right as you pull in the main entrance (see map below). Several carts will be available to assist with move-in. We ask that the carts be loaded and unloaded promptly, returning the carts to the parking area when finished.

Check-In Procedures

- Ring the visitor bell, enter through the vehicle gate, and park to the right.
- Walk to the student housing building (located on the CAU campus).
- Check in with the housing staff to receive your room assignment, key, and access card.
- Move belongings into room.
- Assemble at 17:00 in the Skyway Café for dinner, campus tour, and orientation.

ABOUT YOUR ROOM

CAU Residence Hall rooms are spread out over three floors and each room can accommodate two students. Students will be paired with roommates of the same gender, although floors and housing wings are not separated by gender.

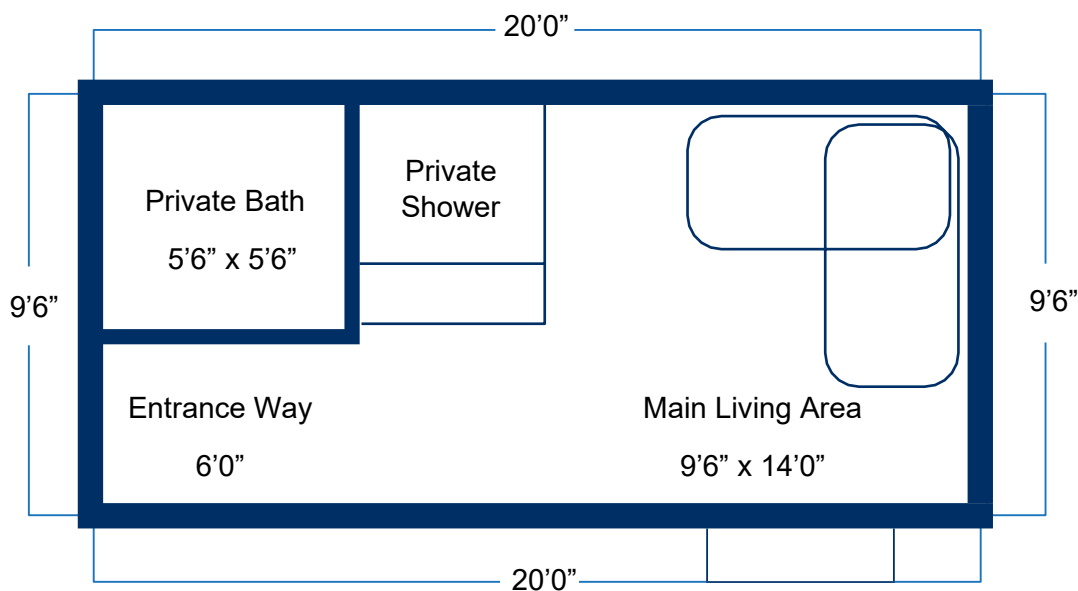
At the time a student first occupies a room, it will be clean and properly organized with appropriate furnishings and linens.



Room Furnishings

Your assigned space will come with a bed, desk, dresser, and closet/wardrobe.

- Beds are twin-sized and are designed to be bunked.
- Linens, including sheets, comforter, pillow, and bath towels, are provided for each student.
- A desk and desk chair are provided for each student.
- Dressers are provided for each student and have either two or three drawers.
- Closet spaces are provided for each student. Some students will have free standing wardrobes as closets, which have comparable dimensions to built-in closet spaces.
- One (1) mini refrigerator is provided in each room for students to share.
- All windows have curtains and student rooms are carpeted.

TECHNOLOGY AT CAU

Internet

Wireless internet connection is available in the Residence Hall rooms, Skyway Café, and main Administration Building.

Phone

There are no landline phones in the Residence Hall for student use.

Cable TV

While cable access is available, televisions are not provided in individual student rooms. However, there are TVs with cable access located on the first-floor lounge.



CAU AMENITIES

Recreation Center

The Recreation Center is located across from the Residence Hall and includes tennis courts, basketball court, sand volleyball court, 6-lane pool, game tables, weight room, and gym.

Whether you choose to get your heart rate up on one of the treadmills, stationary bikes, elliptical machines, lift weights using our dumbbells, weight machines or all-in-one machines, you will find plenty of fitness options just a walk away. A shirt and shoes are required in the weight room and gym. Headphones for music are strongly encouraged.

Housing Office

The Housing Office is open each day from 08:00 to 16:00 and 19:00 to 23:00. You can check out game and sporting equipment, cleaning supplies, and ask questions.

Laundry Rooms

Each wing on each floor has a laundry room. Services are free and do not require you to carry change or a card to use. Powdered or liquid laundry detergent or liquid packs will be provided for use in CAU machines.

Skyway Café

The Skyway Café is located next to the Residence Hall on the CAU campus. A rotating menu is prepared for the serving line each day by our Café Manager and food service team. The dining facility provides students with both indoor and outdoor seating spaces to gather with friends and classmates.
